tone: EVENTIDE

- 1 LORD who may [dwell in] your tabernacle?*
- Who may abide upon your [holy] hill?
- 2 **Whoever leads a blameless life and [does what] is right,***
who speaks the [truth from] his heart,
- 3 there is no guile upon his tongue; ... he does no evil [to] his friend;*
- he does not heap contempt up-[on] his neighbor.
- 4 **In his sight the wicked [is] rejected,***
but he honors those who [fear] the LORD.

Antiphon

- and does not take [back] his word.
- 6 **He does not give his money in [hope] of gain,***
