



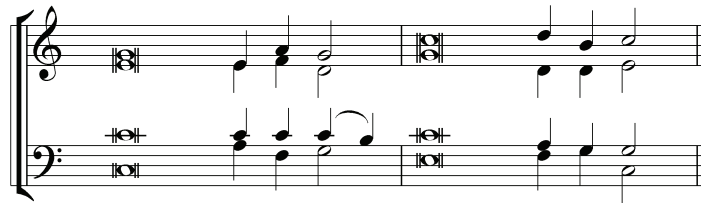
- 5 O LORD you are my portion [and] my cup;*
